THE GOSPEL according to Saint MATTHEW.

CHAPTER I.

1 THE book of the generation of Jesus Christ,  
 2 the son of David, the son of Abraham.  
 3 Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Ja-  
 4 cob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;  
 5 and Judas begat Phares and Zari; of Za-  
 6 rai; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom be-  
 7 gat Aram;  
 8 and Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab  
 9 begat Assa; and Assa begat Saron;  
 10 and Saron begat Jachin; and Jachin begat  
 11 Josab; and Josab begat Joram; and Joram  
 12 begat Ozias; and Ozias begat Joatham; and  
 13 Joatham begat Achaz; and Achaz begat  
 14 Ezechias; and Ezechias begat Manasses;  
 15 and Manasses begat Josias; and Josias  
 16 begat Jechonias; and Jechonias begat  
 17 Zorobabel; and Zorobabel begat Abud; and Abud be-  
 18 gat Eliakim; and Eliakim begat Azor;  
 19 and Azor begat Sadoc; and Sadoc begat  
 20 Achim; and Achim begat Eliud;  
 21 and Eliud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar be-  
 22 gat Mathan; and Mathan begat Jacob;  
 23 and Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Ma-  
 24 ry; of whom was born Jesus, who is called  
 25 Christ.  
 26 So all the generations from Abraham to Da-  
 27 vid are fourteen generations; and from Da-  
 28 vid are fourteen generations; and from Da-  
 29 vid are fourteen generations; and from Da-  
 30 vid unto Christ are fourteen generations.  
 31 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this  
 32 wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused  
 33 to Joseph, before they came together, she was  
 34 found with child of the Holy Ghost.  
 35 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man,  
 36 and not willing to make her a public example,  
 37 was minded to put her away privily.  
 38 But while he thought on these things, be-  
 39 hold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a  
 40 dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear  
 41 not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that  
 42 which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost:  
 43 and she shall bring forth a son, and thou  
 44 shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save  
 45 his people from all iniquities.  
 46 Now all this was done, that it might be ful-  
 47 filled which was spoken of the Lord by the pro-  
 48 phet, saying,  
 49 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and  
 50 shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his  
 51 name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is,  
 52 God with us.  
 53 Then Joseph, being raised from sleep, did  
 54 as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and  
 55 took unto him his wife.  
 56 And knew her not, till she had brought forth  
 57 her first-born son: and he called his name JESUS.  
 58

CHAPTER II.

1 NOW when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of  
 2 Judaea in the days of Herod the king, be-  
 3 hold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,  
 4 saying, Where is he that is born King of the  
 5 Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and  
 6 we come to worship him.  
 7 When Herod the king had heard these things,  
 8 he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him:  
 9 and he gathered all the chief priests and scri-  
 10 bes of the Jews together, he demanded of them  
 11 where Christ should be born.  
 12 And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Ju-  
 13 dah: for thus it is written by the prophet,  
 14 And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Juda,  
 15 art not the least among the princes of Juda: for  
 16 out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall  
 17 rule my people Israel.  
 18 Then Herod, when he had privily called the  
 19 wise men, inquired of them diligently what time  
 20 the star appeared.  
 21 And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said, Go  
 22 and search diligently for the young child; and  
 23 when ye have found him, bring the word again,  
 24 that I may come and worship him: then they de-  
 25 parted.  
 26 When they had heard of the king, they de-  
 27 parted: and lo, the star, which they saw in the east,  
 28 went before them, till it came and stood over  
 29 the young child.  
 30 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with  
 31 exceeding great joy.  
 32 And when they were come into the house,  
 33 they saw the young child with his mother, Ma-  
 34 ry, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when  
 35 they had opened their treasures, they presented  
 36 unto him gifts, gold, and frankincense, and  
 37 myrrh.  
 38 And being warned of God in a dream that  
 39 they should not return to Herod, they departed  
 40 into their own country another way.  
 41 And when they were departed, behold, the  
 42 angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream,  
 43 saying, Arise, and take the young child and his  
 44 mother, and flee into Egypt: and when thou  
 45 shalt have heard that I say so, return into  
 46 Israel: for he shall die there.  
 47 And he arose, and took the young child and  
 48 his mother, and fled into Egypt, and was there  
 49 until the death of Herod: that it might be ful-  
 50 filled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet,  
 51 saying, Out of Egypt have I called my Son.  
 52 When Herod was dead, Joseph was warned in a  
 53 dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child  
 54 and his mother, and go into the land of Israel:  
 55 for I am dead, and thou shalt live: when thou  
 56 shalt have heard that I say so, return into  
 57 Israel: for thou shalt live there.  
 58 And he arose, and took the young child and  
 59 his mother, and came into the land of Israel:  
 60 and when he heard that Archelaus did reign  
 61 in Judaea in the room of his father Herod,  
 62 he was afraid to go thither: notwithstanding,  
 63 being warned of God in a dream, he turned aside  
 64 into the parts of Galilee:  
 65 and he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth:  
 66 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken  
 67 of by the prophets,  
 68 Nazareth.  
 69 And when Jesus began to teach, the people  
 70 said, How cometh this man here, seeing that  
 71 Joseph is a Galilean?  
 72 And saying, Reply ye: for the kingdom of  
 73 heaven is at hand.
